DUAL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

1. Mutual agreement among all parties is required. This includes student/parents, coach/sponsors of the two activities and the Activities Director.
2. If all parties listed above are not in complete agreement, then dual participation will not occur.
3. A plan must be formulated **before** dual participation begins, outlining practice and contest participation to avoid as many conflicts as possible. Changes may be made with the agreement of all parties mentioned.
4. Any disciplinary action taken by either sponsor shall apply equally and concurrently in both programs.
5. If a student is unable to accommodate dual participation, he/she will be able to withdraw from either program. The following must be met prior to termination:
 - a. The student must personally inform the coach/sponsor of the program from which he/she is withdrawing before the activity is dropped. Failure to fulfill these requirements by the student will cause the student to be dropped from both programs.
 - b. If a student is going to drop one activity, both coach/sponsors and student must meet to finalize any obligations incurred by the student.
6. Primary and secondary activities need to be chosen by the student before the start of the season of each activity. Secondary activities will work around primary activities schedules and practices.

**Sponsors will clearly state expectations on attached pages and provide copies of the agreement to all parties.
Contract will be kept on file in the Activities Director office.**
